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**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT HEARINGS**

On August 1, 2025, Maryland-American Water Company (“MAWC” or the “Company”) filed an application with the Commission for authority to increase its rates and charges for water service and to amend its tariff provisions for the two water companies it operates, including supporting testimony and schedules.<sup>1</sup> A pre-hearing conference was held on September 8, 2025, during which the Commission adopted a procedural schedule for the matter, except for the schedule for evening public comment hearings.<sup>2</sup>

Notice is hereby given that hearings for the purpose of soliciting comments from the public will be held on Monday, December 8, 2025, beginning at 6:00 p.m., at the Harford County of Council Chamber, 212 S. Written comments on this matter may also be submitted electronically or by first-class mail by December 31, 2025. MAWC's service area at least two times each before **December 8, 2025 and December 15, 2025** respectively.

MAWC is also directed to place on its homepage a notice of the public hearings in a manner that a customer need not click the link to determine the date, time, and purpose of the public hearings or the date by which public comments must be filed. Further, MAWC is directed to employ any routinely used social media platforms, such as Twitter or Facebook, and any other usual means of communication to further notify its customers of the public hearings and the dates by which public comments must be filed.
