NOTICE INITIATING A RULEMAKING, OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND RULEMAKING SESSION

On February 11, 2026,¹ the Interconnection Work Group Leader filed with the Commission a Petition for Rulemaking in the above-mentioned matter along with proposed regulations in compliance with Commission Order No. 91984.² The proposed regulations include revisions to COMAR 20.50.09. Accordingly, the Commission hereby initiates an Administrative Docket, RM 94, to consider regulations as submitted by the Work Group Leader.

The Commission now invites interested parties to file comments on the matter by March 5, 2026.
