## Second Public Hearing Oct. 19 for Costen Solar Project in Somerset County

(BALTIMORE, MD) – The Maryland Public Service Commission will hold a second virtual public comment hearing on a proposed 10.625 MW solar generating facility in Somerset County. Community residents and other interested parties are welcome to take part in the hearing which is scheduled for **Tuesday, October 19, 2021 at 7 p.m.** Public Utility Law Judge Christine Burke will preside. The first public comment hearing in this case was held on June 29, 2021.

Costen Solar, Inc. has applied to the Commission for what is known as a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN), which grants an applicant the authority to construct an energy generating station or high-voltage transmission line in Maryland. Costen Solar's project is slated to be constructed on about 57 acres of property owned by Chesapeake Renewable Energy, LLC located at 33001 Costen Road in Pocomoke City. The project will include approximately 34,000 solar panels and an interconnection to Choptank Electric Cooperative's Edgewood substation.
