NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT HEARINGS

On October 14, 2025, Potomac Electric Power Company (“Pepco”) submitted to the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) an Application for Adjustment to its Retail Rates for the Distribution of Electric Energy and implementation of a fully forecasted test year (“FFTY”) in its Maryland service territory (“Application”).<sup>1</sup> Pepco also filed revised tariffs, supporting testimony, exhibits, supplemental information, and the filing requirements as adopted by the Commission in Order No. 91181.<sup>2</sup>

A prehearing scheduling conference was held on November 18, 2025. On December 8, 2025, the Commission adopted a procedural schedule for the matter,<sup>3</sup> except for the schedule for evening public hearings that will be held in Pepco’s service territory.

Notice is hereby given that two hearings for the purpose of soliciting comments from the public will be held virtually on Tuesday, April 14, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. and on Friday, April 17,

Written comments on this matter may also be submitted electronically or by first-class mail no later than June 1, 2026. Commenters utilizing the Public Comment Dropbox for the first time are required to complete a one-time registration. All comments must include a reference to Case No. 9820. Pepco is hereby directed to publish a notice of the public comment hearings, including the caption, case number, the time, date, access information for the hearing, and the deadline for written comments for the hearings, at least two times by April 14, 2026 and April 17, 2026, respectively, as a display advertisement in newspapers in general circulation throughout Pepco's service area.

Pepco is also directed to place on its homepage a notice of the public hearing in a manner that a customer need not click the link to determine the date, time, and purpose of the public hearing
