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**NOTICE OF “COMMISSIONER HAROLD WILLIAMS  
SUPPLIER DIVERSITY HEARING” - PUBLIC CONFERENCE 52**

The Commission will continue its annual review of utility supplier diversity efforts in Public Conference 52 (“PC 52”) by holding a hearing to begin at 10:00 a.m., on Monday, July 13, 2026, in the Frank O. Heintz Hearing Room, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 16th Floor, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. The theme of this year’s conference is “The Business of Powering Communities—Where Energy Investment Meets Opportunity.”

The purpose of the hearing is:

- 1) to consider the upcoming report from the Commission’s Technical Staff that summarizes the data from the 2025 Maryland Supplier Diversity Program Annual Reports filed with the Commission by the Reporting Companies,<sup>1</sup> including any issues that may have come to Staff’s attention during its review of the 2025 Annual Reports (“Staff Report”); and
- 2) to hear comments from each Reporting Company on the Staff

Report and to discuss with representatives of each company<sup>2</sup> the status of the company's efforts toward implementing the MOU, including goals, data collection, resolution of disputes, etc.

At the hearing, the Commission will receive comments and presentations from certain invited parties, including utility companies, diverse suppliers, and Staff. Written comments on this matter may be submitted electronically or by first-class mail by July 1, 2026. Comments submitted electronically must be submitted through the Commission's Public Comment Dropbox, which can be accessed through the Commission's website at <https://psc.maryland.gov/>.
