**NOTICE OF ADDITIONAL PUBLIC COMMENT HEARING**

In Order No. 92249,<sup>1</sup> the Commission granted the Office of People’s Counsels request for an in-person public comment hearing to be scheduled after the conclusion of the evidentiary hearings in the above-mentioned proceeding.

Accordingly, the Commission gives notice that an in-person only, public comment hearing will be held on Monday, June 22, 2026, beginning at 6:00 p.m., at the Montgomery College, Rockville Campus, in the Technical Center, TC-136 Lecture Hall, located at 51 Mannakee Street, Rockville, Maryland. Attendees are encouraged to refer to the attached campus map, which identifies the entrance to the auditorium and the parking areas closest to the lecture hall. The most convenient parking is Lots 7 and 8, where attendees may park in the white-lined student parking spaces. Upon entering through the doors identified on the attached map, the lecture hall will be immediately to the right.

The purpose of the hearing is to ensure all affected Washington Gas Light Company’s (“Washington Gas”) customers have an opportunity to comment on the proposed rate increase. If

Washington Gas is hereby directed to publish a notice of the public comment hearings, including the caption, case number, the time, date, access information for the hearing, and the deadline for written comments for the hearings, at least two times before June 22, 2026, as a display advertisement in newspapers in general circulation throughout Washington Gas' service area.

Washington Gas is also directed to place on its homepage a notice of the public hearing in a manner that a customer need not click the link to determine the date, time, and purpose of the public hearing or the date by which public comments must be filed. Further, Washington Gas is directed to employ any routinely used social media platforms, such as Twitter or Facebook, and any other means of communication at its disposal to further notify its customers of the public hearing and the date by which public comments must be filed.
