Pepco is also directed to place on its homepage a notice of the public hearing in a manner that a customer need not click the link to determine the date, time, and purpose of the public hearing or the date by which public comments must be filed. Further, Pepco is directed to employ any routinely used social media platforms, such as Twitter or Facebook, and any other means of communication at its disposal to further notify its customers of the public hearing and the date by which public comments must be filed.
