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NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT **AND RULEMAKING SESSION**

On July 7, 2026, the Interconnection Work Group (“Work Group”) filed a petition requesting that the Commission initiate a rulemaking session to adopt permanent regulations to replace the emergency regulations currently in effect in the above-captioned matter, which are scheduled to expire on October 10, 2026.¹

The Commission hereby invites interested parties to file comments² on the proposed permanent regulations by July 24, 2026. The comments should be addressed to Andrew S. The Administrative Docket number (“RM 94”) must appear in the subject line of the cover letter.³

The Commission further gives notice that it will conduct an in-person only rulemaking session on August 3, 2026, beginning at 1:00 p.m., in the Frank O. Heintz Hearing Room, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 16th Floor, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. The purpose of

the rulemaking session is to consider whether to publish for notice and comment the proposed permanent regulations, as submitted in the July 7, 2026 Work Groups petition, or as revised based on comments received. If the Commission approves the proposed permanent regulations for publication, the proposed permanent regulations will be published in the *Maryland Register* for notice and comment as provided for by the Maryland Administrative Procedures Act.
