### **NOTICE INITIATING A RULEMAKING, COMMENT OPPORTUNITY, AND VIRTUAL RULEMAKING SESSION**

On September 10, 2026, the Commission's Technical Staff ("Staff") submitted proposed draft nuclear procurement regulations and requested that the Commission convene a rulemaking session to consider the proposed regulations.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, the Commission hereby initiates Administrative Docket RM 98 to consider the draft regulations as submitted by Staff.

Comments on the draft regulations shall be e-filed by December 14, 2026.<sup>2</sup> All comments should be addressed to Andrew S. Johnston, Executive Secretary, Maryland Public Service Commission, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, 16<sup>th</sup> Floor, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. The Administrative Docket number ("RM 90") must appear in the subject line of the cover letter.<sup>3</sup>
