**REVISED SCHEDULING NOTICE AND EXTENSION OF
PUBLIC COMMENT DEADLINE**

On August 28, 2020, the Commission postponed the evidentiary hearings in this case.¹
The Commission hereby reschedules the evidentiary hearings for September 24 and 25, 2020.²

Accordingly, in order to accommodate the virtual nature of the evidentiary hearings, all parties to this case are required to prepare and email an exhibit list along with pre-marked copies of any exhibits that they may introduce at the evidentiary hearing to Susan Howard by 12 noon on Monday, September 21, 2020, and copy the other parties.³ Parties may amend exhibit and participant lists that they may have filed prior to this Notice. All parties to the case are also required to provide Susan Howard⁴ an updated list of individuals who will participate in the hearing by 12 noon on Monday, September 21, 2020.
