NOTICE OF RULE MAKING SESSION

The Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) hereby gives notice that it will conduct a rule making session on September 10, 2015 beginning at 10:00 a.m. and September 11, 2015 (if needed) beginning at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission’s 16th Floor Hearing Room, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. On July 24, 2015, Mr. Odogwu Obi Linton (the PSC Leader in Maryland Public Service Commission Public Conference 35), filed Revised Draft Regulations,¹ replacing and where appropriate, incorporating proposals from all prior filings in this proceeding. The purpose of this rule making session is to consider whether to publish these proposed revisions to COMAR 20.32, 20.53, and 20.59 in the *Maryland Register* for notice and comment as provided for by the Maryland Administrative Procedures Act.
