SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF VIRTUAL PRE- HEARING CONGERENCE

On May 13, 2025, the Commission issued a "Notice of Virtual Pre-Hearing Conference," in the above-captioned matter, set for June 10, 2025 at 10:00 a.m., for the purpose of establishing a procedural schedule, and to address any other preliminary matters,¹ including the three requests filed with the Commission for appeal of intervenor status.² The Notice instructed parties and intervenors wishing to attend the virtual hearing to contact kimberly.shock@maryland.gov for further information.

The Commission hereby issues this Supplemental Notice of the virtual pre-conference hearing to clarify the participation guidelines for the upcoming virtual pre-conference hearing. Only the parties listed in Commission Order No. 91645, including those petitioners granted intervenor party status (detailed in Exhibit A of that Order),³ who believe they may need to actively

participate and speak on the above matters send an email to kimberly.shock@maryland.gov by Monday, June 9, 2025.

The virtual pre-conference hearing will be conducted through WebEx. Only those parties and intervenors who requested to participate will receive an email with the WebEx link, prior to the hearing, to join the virtual pre-hearing conference.⁴

The pre-hearing conference is intended solely to set a procedural schedule and resolve related preliminary matters; it is not an opportunity for substantive arguments or general comment. Therefore, the Commission will only recognize attendees to the extent it seems necessary to accomplish those tasks. It is not expected that everyone who seeks to participate will be asked to speak at the hearing. Interested persons and parties who are not actively participating in this matter are again invited to observe the live stream of the virtual hearing via the Commission's YouTube Channel.⁵
